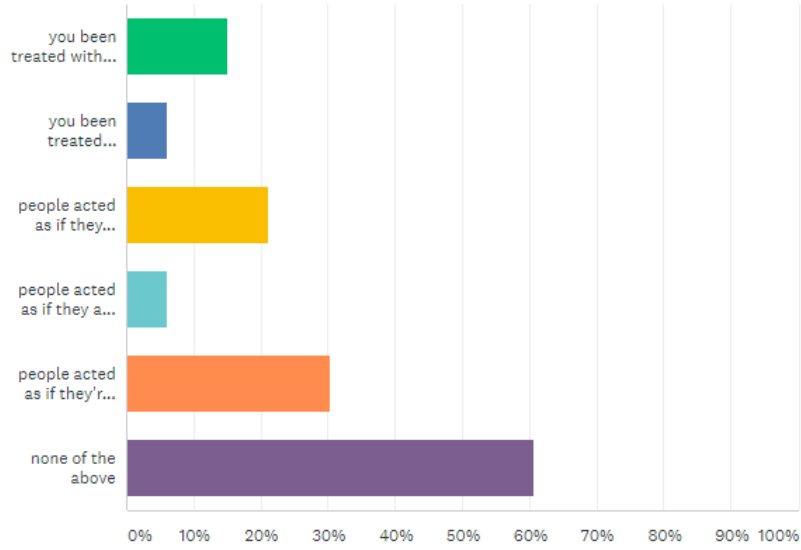

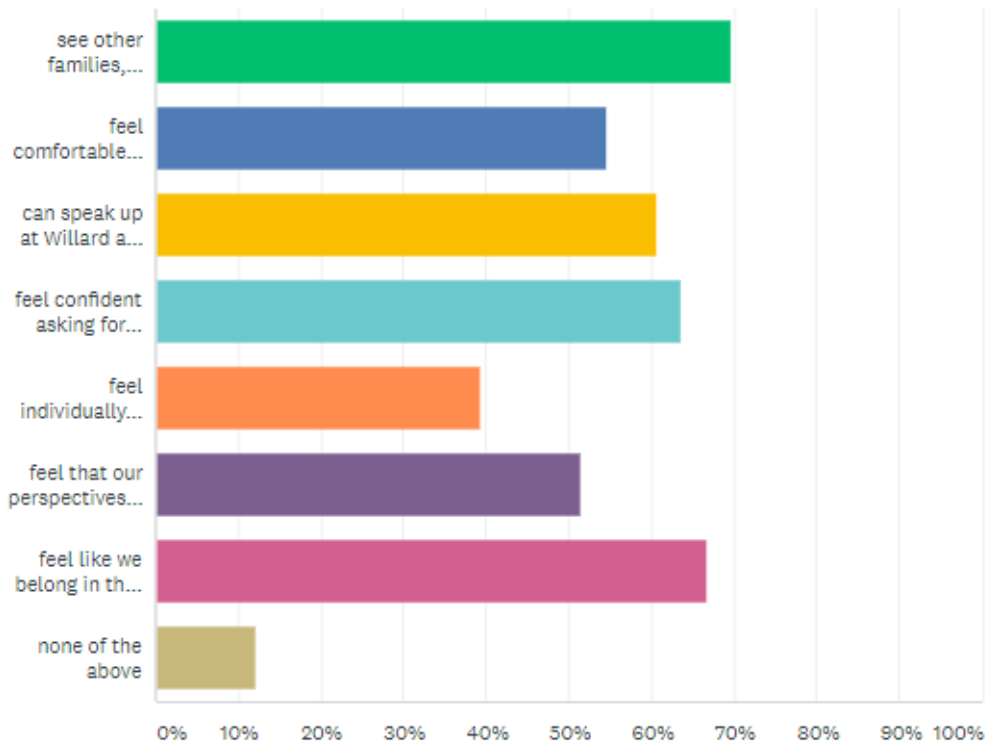

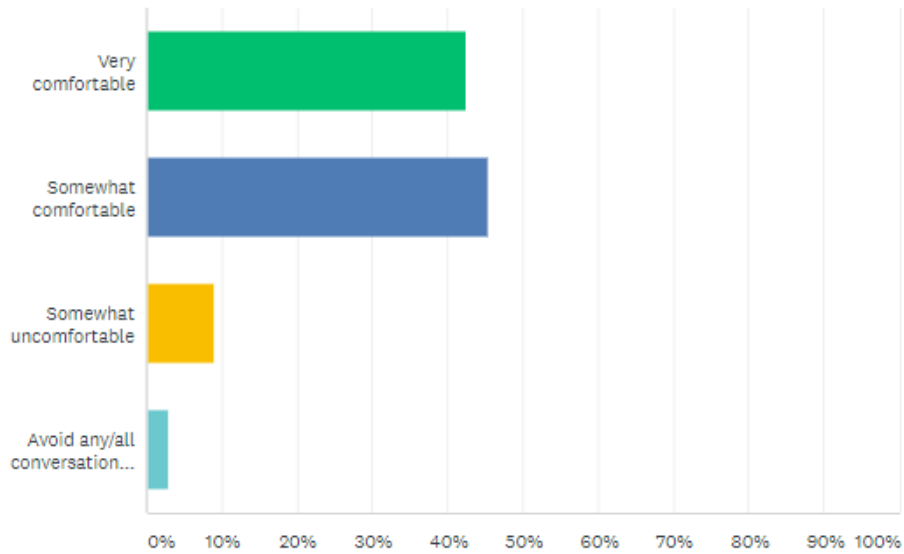

How comfortable are you with talking about race and racism?

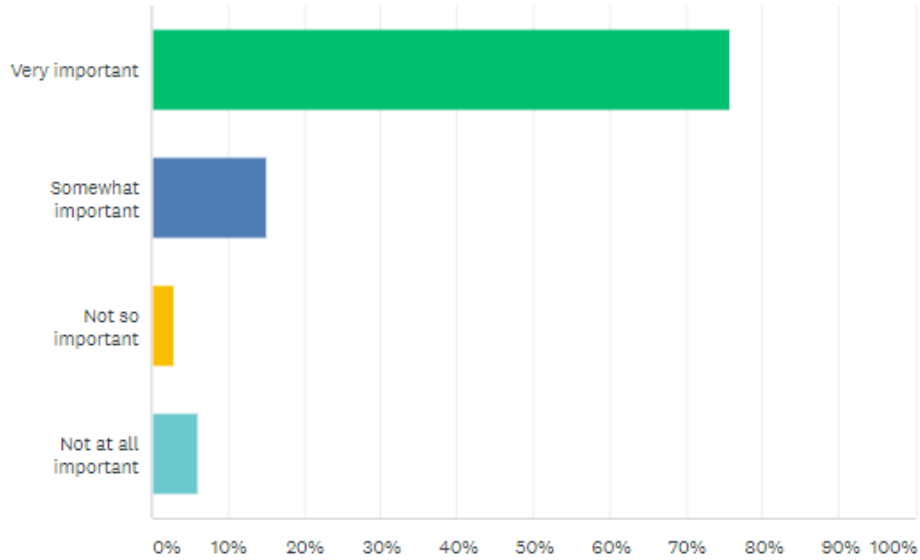

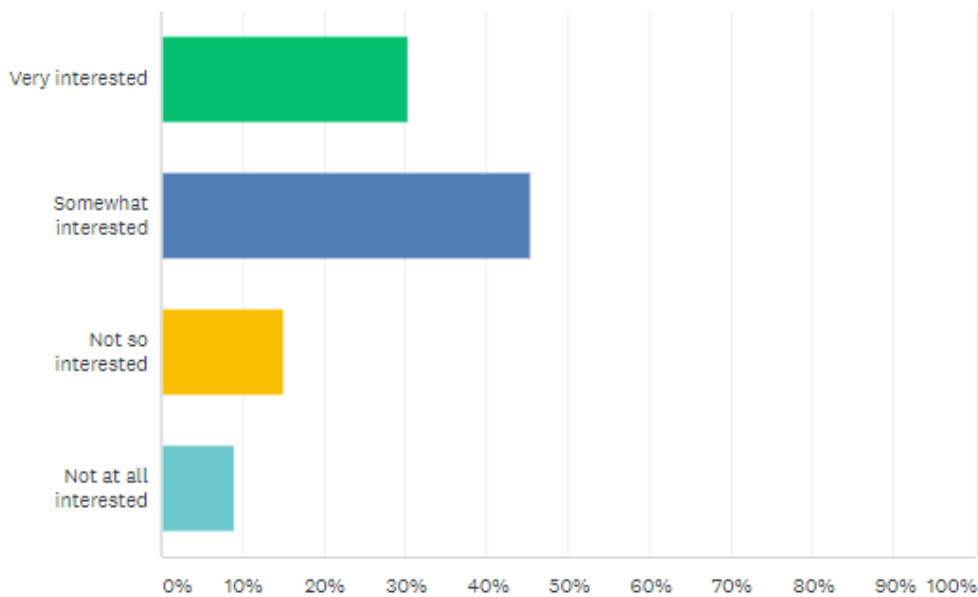

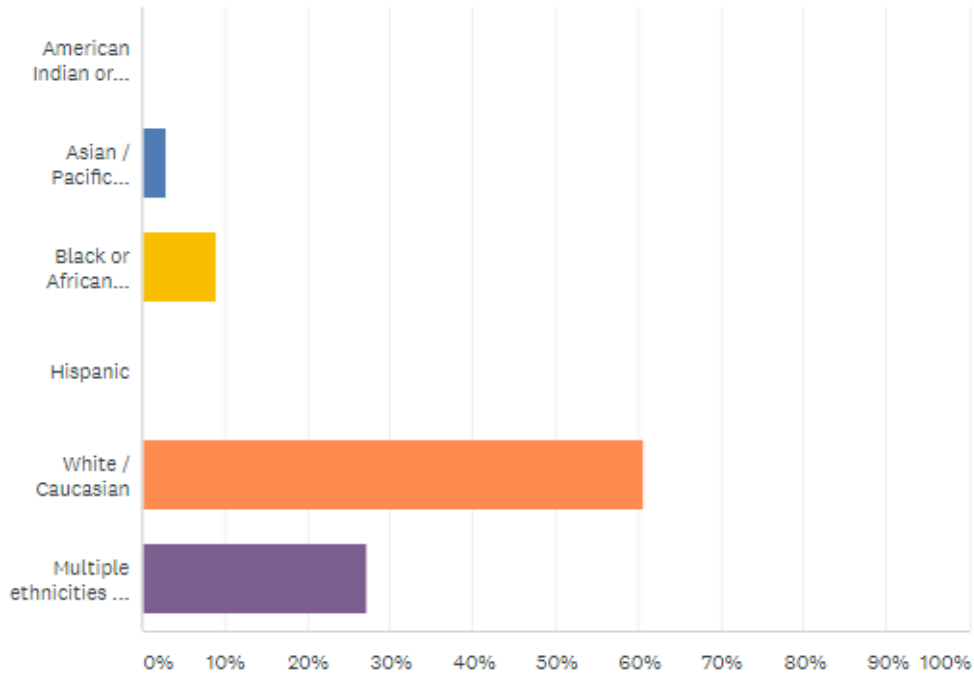

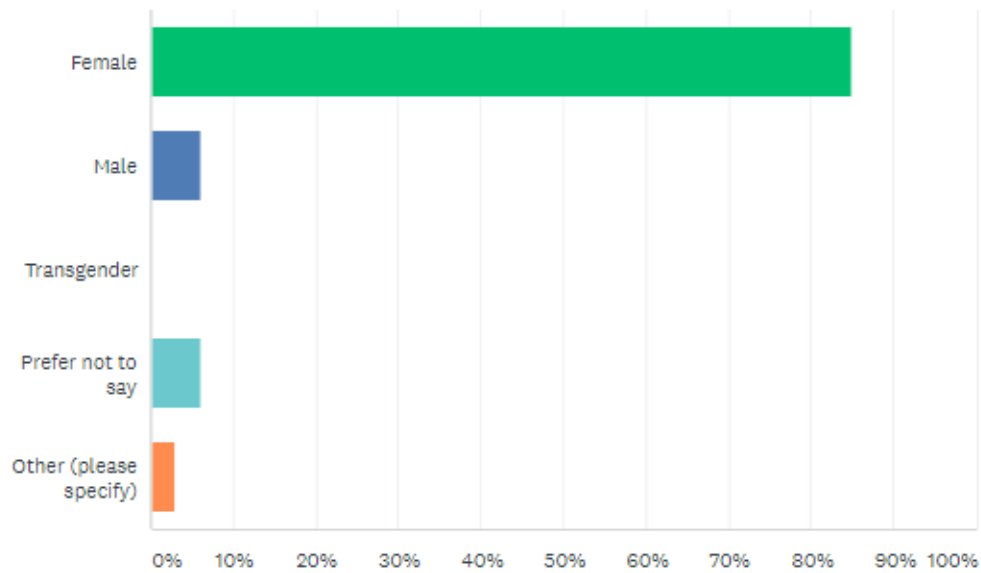
